# Create a future where lack of education no longer traps families in poverty.

#### For Martina, a mother of eight living in rural Timor-Leste, escaping domestic violence was the first step in her journey to a new life.

The shelter where Martina sought refuge, is a partner in Caritas Australia's Protection Program, a holistic community-wide program that offers women like Martina economic empowerment and a life of safety in a supportive environment.


"After I left the shelter, I felt confident for my future. They really helped me to learn how to be strong; how to change my life to support myself and to have some money to support my children," Martina says.

When she joined the Caritas Australia supported Protection Program, she received vital training in microfinance, management and saving money. Now, Martina has her independence and ability to earn an income to support her family and provide an education.

Gender-based violence is a critical issue for women in Timor-Leste, and this is the most reported crime to the National Vulnerable Persons Unit.

Your support enables Caritas to continue this important work with vulnerable women like Martina and her family.



## Leaving a Legacy of Love.

Preparing your Will helps to look after your loved ones and gives peace of mind. We understand that your family and friends come first and that leaving a gift in your Will is a personal decision.

Whether you're writing a new Will or amending an existing one, including Caritas Australia is simple.

#### There are three different types of gifts you can consider:

- A **specific** gift is a sum of money or property. You can ask your solicitor to draft a cash gift to account for inflation.
- A residuary gift is the remainder of your estate after all expenses, debts and taxes have been paid, and after any specific gifts.
- A percentage gift is a percentage of your residuary estate. This gift is used if you wish to divide your estate among a number of people or organisations.

Your generous gift will make a real difference. Whatever you decide, we recommend that you work with a solicitor to write your new Will, or amend an existing Will.

Your solicitor should ensure that your Will includes the correct legal name of our organisation and ensure that the gift can still be made if our organisation changes its name during your lifetime.

### The wording for your Will.

It's easy to include Caritas Australia in your Will. You can use the suggested wording provided below.

#### I give...

(Please insert the appropriate statement from the following options:)

- A. The sum of \$ [insert value of your gift] or
- B. The residue of my estate or
- C. [insert number] % of the residue of my estate to the Australian Episcopal Conference of the Roman Catholic Church for the general purposes of Caritas Australia (ABN 90 970 605 069) absolutely. The receipt of the authorised officer of the organisation shall be sufficient discharge to my executor.
